LAUNCH SITE RULES

- You must be a homeowner in the Sherwood Lakes/ Isles Association. **If a guest uses the boat launch, the homeowner in Sherwood Lakes/Isles must be an approved resident and be with the guest at all times.** Sherwood Lakes/Isles Associations reserves the right to tow vehicles that are not permitted.
- Each vessel must have at least one United States Coast Guard approved personal floatation device (PFD) per person onboard. Any youth under the age of 12 must wear a PFD. Vessels 16-foot and greater in length must also carry a throwable PFD.
- Boaters enter the water at their own risk.
- All boats must be seaworthy with appropriate registration and insurance.
- You may not store personal property or leave boats unattended.
- Vehicles and trailers must be parked in such a manner as to allow others the use of the ramp. Trailers and hitches must be attached to tow vehicles at all times.
- Be alert to weather conditions and other boats.
- Be aware of other vessels, personal watercraft, canoes, kayaks and other human-powered craft.
- Personal water crafts such as jet skis and water skis are not permitted.
- Boats must operate at moderate speed with little wake and all boating and fishing laws will be observed.
- Do not let children near launch sites without adult supervision.
- I agree to securely lock the gate upon entering AND leaving the boat ramp.

If a key is given out to a guest and a member is not present, Sherwood Lakes Homeowners Association/Isles reserves the right to revoke and no longer allow homeowners access to the ramp. If your key is lost or stolen, please report the key immediately to the Lake Access Management Committee:

Sherwood Lakes/Isles Homeowners Association is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged items or vehicles at the Boat ramp. The Boat ramp is the property of Sherwood Lakes/Isles Homeowners Association, Inc. No Trespassing, violators could be prosecuted.
